Tie-Dye Care Instructions

Dear Customer:

Thank you for purchasing your item from us. At Be you. Always.® Tie Dye Shop we are dedicated to the belief that every person is unique and wonderful exactly as they are. That is why all of our items are dyed individually; to echo that one-of-a-kind essence that only you possess.

Care Instructions:

- *If your item is a shirt: Your garment is unique and dyed by hand. Wash inside out in cold(ish) water, use gentle detergent, and add ½ cup of table salt to the wash cycle. (Your item is 100% cotton and cotton has a tendency to pill over time. Keeping your item inside out will help to reduce that on the outside of the garment). Do not bleach. Line dry.*
- *If your item is a shirt with graphics:, Follow the instructions above and make sure your item is inside out and then iron when completely dry. It will help to maintain the graphic adherence to the garment. If you do not iron it, there should not be any issues with the graphic design. If there is issue, however, please contact us immediately.*
- *If your item is bedding or curtains, wash in cold(ish) water with salt, (you may add fabric softener if you like) and line dry. Iron on cotton setting as needed.*

ALL HAND DYED ITEMS: Some minimal fading may happen and is normal. If you wish to iron, use cotton setting. If you need extra care to remove stains or other marks, use only NON-CHLORINE bleach when needed.
